

URGENT NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

The storage sheds in the basement of our block have been locked now for approximately three months on the advice of the fire brigade. This has caused a lot of problems for some residents who require regular access to their belongings in the basement. Although Tamworth Council have made arrangements for limited access we feel this is woefully inadequate. We would strongly urge the council to provide updates on progress resolving this issue by posting bulletins on the noticeboard for all residents to see

In conjunction with this the Fire Brigade have advised Tamworth Council that the recycling activity in the block will no longer be available after 26th August 2011. Recycling is a crucial part of Government and Local Council targets and we fail to understand why Tamworth Council have not thought of solutions to the issues raised by the Fire Brigade.
