




















The Council has received a petition to make the cul-de-sac in Ninefoot Lane, Belgrave, a no-parking area as follows:-

The cul-de-sac often has 2 or 3 cars parked which means that large vehicles such as delivery vans and small lorries have to reverse back down Ninefoot Lane and onto Wilnecote Lane. We feel that this is a dangerous practice because

- i) there are a number of families with small children living in Ninefoot Lane and these often play at the front of their properties and cross the road to play on the grassed area opposite
- ii) vehicles should not have to reverse onto Wilnecote Lane, which is busy and often has fast moving vehicles
