Notice of Application for a Premises Licence Variation under the Licensing Act 2003

It is proposed to license these premises for⁴

The allowance of consumption of alcoholic refreshments within all areas of the Community Stadium, at all times.

To remove conditions from annex 2 and replace with proposed conditions.

To include licensable activities : plays, performances of dance and anything of a similar description to that falling within (e), (f) or (g)

To remove the non-standard times for late night refreshment, supply of alcohol and opening hours.

To add non –standard times for plays, films, indoor sporting events, live music , recorded music , performance of dance, anything of a similar description to that falling within (e), (f) or (g) , late night refreshment , supply of alcohol and opening hours.

Example of wording for the notice and advertisement

- 1)** The notice must be on pale blue paper and not less than A4 size.
- 2)** It must be printed in black and not less than 16 font size.
- 3)** Delete those types of application that do not apply.
- 4)** Briefly describe the activities that you have applied for on the operating schedule in your application, including opening times. Or the variation to the existing licensed activities.
- 5)** Insert the date of making the application and the closing date, which is 28 consecutive days starting on the day after the day on which the application is lodged with the Licensing Authority.
