Chiltern Road Estate -

This estate should be served by a dedicated portable polling station located on the estate. The current location is not central to the population of the polling district, which is the Chiltern estate. If this requires the estate to become a separate polling district we would support this.

Marrick -

This street is geographically part of the Malham Road polling district, however it is in an adjacent polling district. We propose that the street is moved to ST2 from ST1, as this represents a better geographical alignment with the rest of Malham Road

Trinity Ward

No Changes to polling districts and polling stations.

Wilnecote Ward

The current arrangements of polling districts do not align with the wards natural geography. Polling Districts should better reflect layout and makeup of housing estates. Currently the "Bird estates" are split over two polling districts (WI4 and WI6). We suggest these should be merged into 1 polling district.

The current arrangements are shown as appendix A and our proposals as appendix B.

Following the development on Hedging Lane, we propose that WI3 should be extended south to include the new development on Hedging Lane, they are currently in WI5. It would make more sense for these residents to use the nearby polling station in WI3.

The current arrangements are shown as appendix C and our proposals as appendix D.

Spital Ward

The ward has seen a new development approved and being built on Anker Valley (East of Derby Line). We propose that this polling district (SP6) development have its own polling station on or around the site of the school. A temporary station is used until the school is built.

Following the proposals for the Polling Station Review I have taken the time to consult with the Council Leader, Danny Cook as well as some of his colleagues. I completely support all of his and the Conservative groups suggestions which have been made in feedback from residents in the Tamworth area.

Within the Belgrave and Wilnecote Ward especially, there has been suitable expansions of polling areas allowing them to reflect the local geographical boundaries, due to them being better aligned within the area.

The make-up of new polling districts within the Amington and Castle Ward would make them more accessible for constituents to vote, as it has improved parking facilities which are within walking distance, unlike their current positioning.

Portable Polling Stations on Chiltern Road and in the Glascote Ward will allow them to be recentralised onto the estate to allow the population of the polling district to vote locally, without having them travel too far to do so.
