

**Notice under The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements)  
(Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012  
Paragraph 10;**

The making of the decision **Tamworth Assembly Rooms Project** which is due to be made by Cabinet on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2018 is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred because;

The Project has just completed its design freeze stage on Friday 7 December which has resulted in a revision to the current budget being required. The next Cabinet meeting after this one would be 24<sup>th</sup> January 2019 and waiting until then would result in significant delays and/or costs to the projects. The Project itself is widely publicised and has been in the public domain for a considerable period of time.

Tamworth Borough Council is therefore unable to comply with the requirements under The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 Paragraph 10 in respect of Publicity in connection with the intention to make a Key Decision.

Tamworth Borough Council has taken the following steps to comply with the requirements under The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 Paragraph 10 in respect of the general exception;
