

# Summary Accounts 2024/25

## The Cost of Council Services for 2024/25

The Comprehensive Income and Expenditure Account below details the cost of running Council Services between April 2024 and March 2025, where the money came from to finance those costs along with the surplus or deficit at the year end.

Tamworth Borough Council budgeted to use £1.1m from General Fund balances in 2024/25. The year-end position showed a decrease in balances of £0.6m to £10.1m.

The improvement in the Council's estimated financial position arose mainly from additional income from interest on investments, additional retained business rates income offset by additional interest payable to the Housing Revenue Account and other minor overspends.

## Housing Revenue Account

The overall revenue financial position relating to council housing shows a increase in balances for the year of £2.1m from £2.2m to £4.3m - to be carried forward to 2025/26.

This equates to an underspend of £1m when compared to the approved budget for the year, mainly due to increased investment income on balances.
