Freedom of Information – Request for Information

With regards to your recent enquiry for information held by the Authority under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act. Please find the information you requested below with reference in the box to your original enquiry for clarity where multiple answers are required.

Details of Your Request

Please could I request the following information under the freedom of information act of 2000:-

- *I would like to know the budget that the council has allocated for redevelopment in the area such as highway improvements, regeneration projects and park and land areas.*
- *Where the money is looking to be spent*
- *The location that the councils are focused on renovating*
- *How much has been spent on these areas in the past 5 years*
- *How much is expected to be spent on these in the forthcoming 5 years (if this information is available)*
- *Finally, how many New build houses are looking to be built in specific areas (Areas that the council listed in point 3)*

The response to your request as follows:

- **As a two tier authority Tamworth Borough Council has no responsibility for highway assets, all redevelopment would be carried out by Staffordshire County Council.**

There are no park or land areas designated for redevelopment.

The value of the regeneration projects can be obtained from the Medium Term Financial Strategy Report which is published on the website – Regenerations schemes with the Housing Capital Programme page.

- Annual Capital spend on all projects is reported to Cabinet on an annual basis in June / July of each year (Capital Outturn Reports) – not all projects have been operating for the full 5 years
