for a review of a Premises Licence

The grounds of the application for review are:

- **The premises were subject to a compliance testing operation on 27 September 2013 during which alcoholic drinks were sold by a member of staff to persons under 18 years;**
- **Other incidents which have occurred at the premises on: 29/07/2012; 24/08/2012; 01/01/2013; 19/01/2013; 22/02/2013; 29/03/2013; 06/04/2013; 26/05/2013; 18/08/2013; and 20/09/2013.**
- **Staffordshire Police believe the premises licence holder needs to do more to promote the licensing objectives of prevention of crime and disorder and the protection of children from harm.**
