

PUBLIC NOTICE - REVIEW APPLICATION

Notice of Application for a review of a Premises Licence under the Licensing Act 2003

Address of premises about which an application for review has been made:

Ems Bar, 111 Lichfield Street Tamworth, Staffordshire, B79 7QB

The grounds of the application for review are:

That on 29 September 2013, and 21 December 2013 members of staff selling drinks to customers at Ems Bar 111 Lichfield Street Tamworth, Staffordshire, B79 7QB sold alcohol to volunteers who were under the age of 18. No identification or any proof of age was sought by those persons. Additionally, since July 2012, there have been 14 incidents attributed to the premises relating to drugs use on the premises, breaches of licence, drunkenness and two underage sales of alcohol. Staffordshire Police believe that the Premises Licence Holder has failed to promote the licensing objectives namely, the Protection of Children from Harm and Prevention of Crime and Disorder and need to do more to meet their obligations.
